Meetings

Field Trips

This year we will endeavour to organise field trips on a more regular basis throughout the year.

Sometimes a brief local trip is all that's required and on Sunday 28 August several club members attended a tutorial session at Lake Te Koutu Park, Cambridge. The aim of that trip was to teach less experienced photographers how to get their camera off Auto function. The next outing will be a trip to Raglan focussing on landscape photography.

Previous trips have included Karangahake Gorge, Te Puna Quarry Park, Glenfield Vintage Railway and Taranaki Falls Walk near Whakapapa.



Competitions

At the beginning of each year, the committee sets the yearly programme of competitions, speakers and workshops. Members submit images for judging based on the set subject or open images. Club members can submit three images, print or digital that may be apportioned between the two competitions subjects, ie all three in one subject or one in one and two in the other.

All members begin as Grade C photographers and by earning points can progress to Grade A. The competition runs throughout the year and members are awarded points based on the judges' findings.

Annual awards include Print of the Year, Photographer of the Year (most points), JW Welch Trophy (Floral) and Best Projected Image.



Five Ways

The Five ways is an interclub photographic competition held annually between Matamata, Te Awamutu, Rotorua, Cambridge and Taupo. Each Club has a turn hosting the event and next year's event will be hosted by Rotorua.

Images are submitted at the end of April to the hosting club for judging and all the clubs get together for a social day and presentation of the results on the first Sunday in July.
