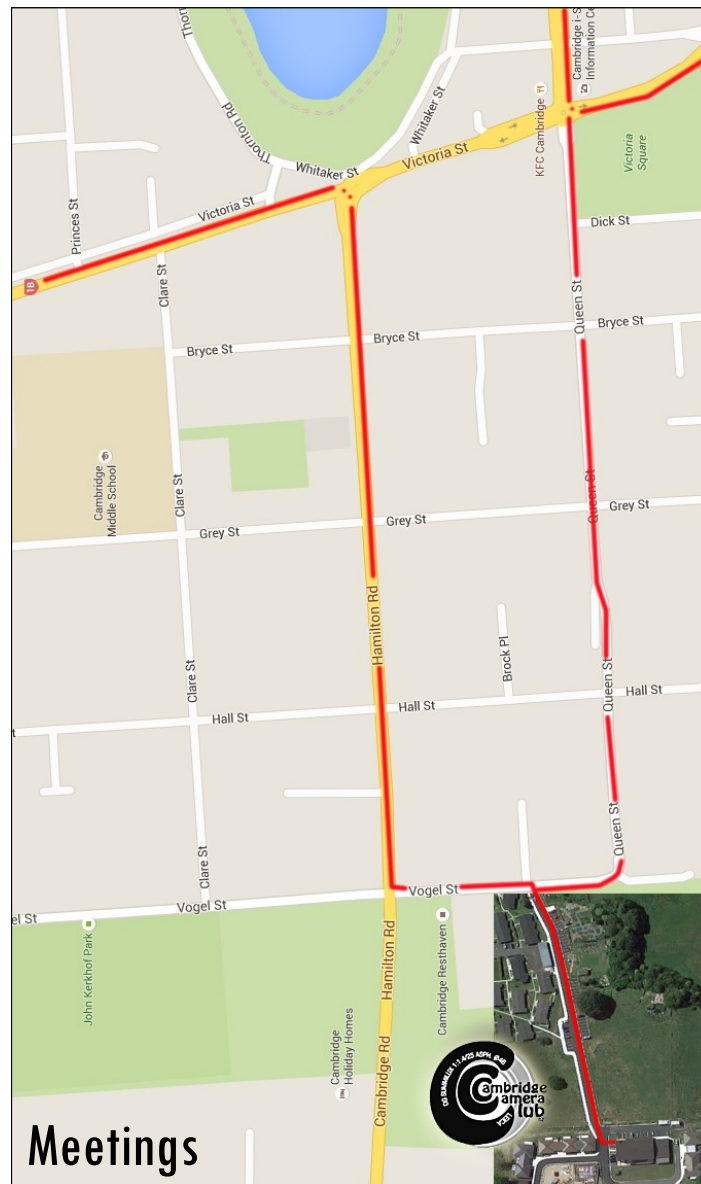

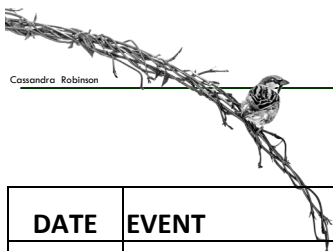

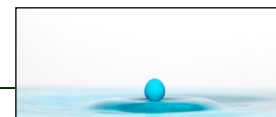

## Competitions

We hold bi-monthly club competitions.

All entries must be submitted by the last Wednesday of the month prior to the showing of entries (eg. Sept Competitions entries should be in by the last Wednesday of August and so on)

**PRINTS** must be matted with a maximum mat size of 510mm x 410mm (20x16 ins). Minimum print sizes should be no smaller than 180mm x 125mm (7x5 ins). The back must be of a suitable material such as cardboard or foam board. Hot Shots in Duke St Cambridge will print and mount your prints at a reasonable rate, but you are responsible for collecting them and making sure they are correctly labeled by the due date.

**PROJECTED IMAGES** must not exceed a maximum size of 1620 pixels horizontal and 1080 pixels vertical. All entries must be supported by a digital file and submitted to [tina\\_tait@xtra.co.nz](mailto:tina_tait@xtra.co.nz) along with an email laying out the grade-title and category, by the due date.

All new members begin in C Grade and by earning points progress to A Grade. The competitions run throughout the year and members are awarded points based on the judges findings. Annual awards include Photographer of the Year, Best Projected Image, Best Print of the Year, Best Creative, Best Wildlife, and Best Floral.

## Sixways

The Sixways is an interclub photographic competition held annually between Matamata, South Waikato, Te Awamutu, Rotorua, Cambridge and Taupo. Each club has a turn hosting the event. Rotorua will be hosting 2018.

Images are submitted at the end of April to the hosting club for judging and all the clubs get together for a social day with a presentation of the results on the first Sunday in July.
