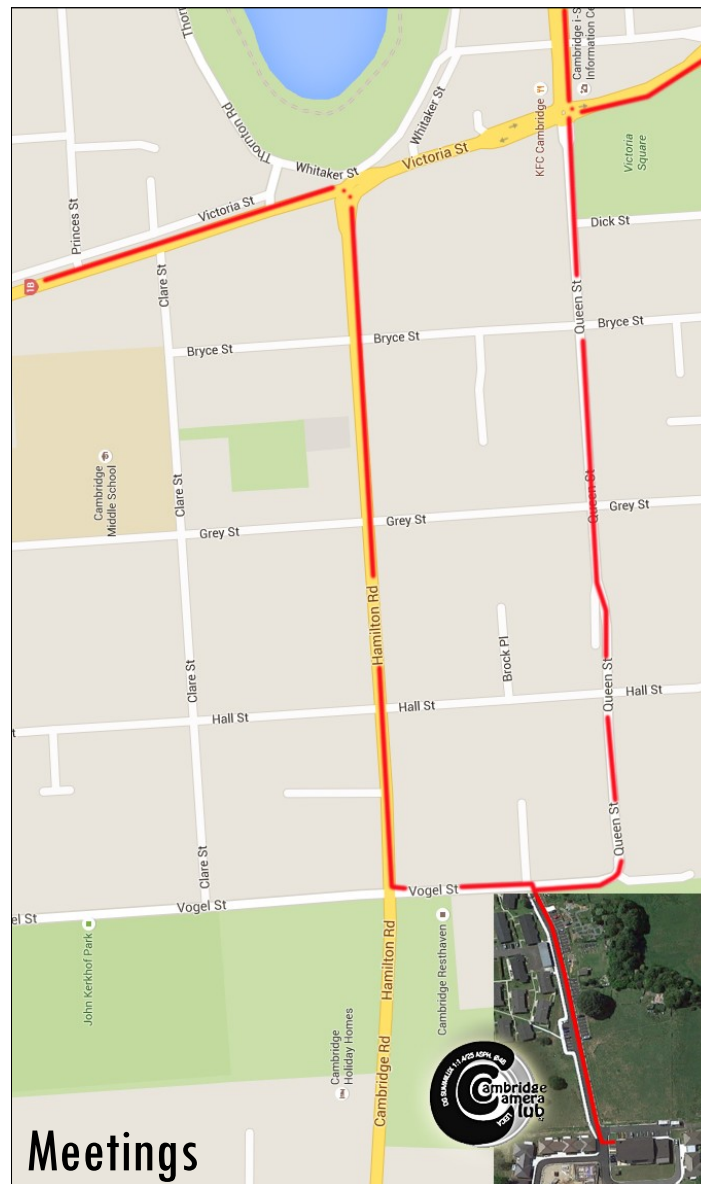

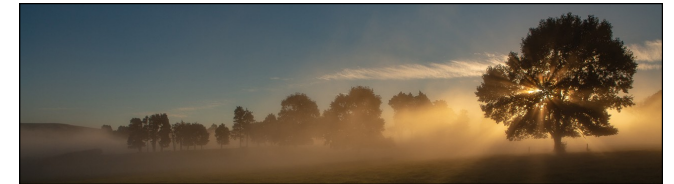

## About Us

## Field Trips

Each year we try to organize field trips on a regular basis throughout the year. The selected images are submitted for judging near the end of the year and the results are returned to the clubs near the end of February. Last year we competed with Islesburgh and Mearns. ## Competitions

We hold bi-monthly club competitions.

All entries must be submitted by the last Wednesday of the month prior to the showing of entries (eg. Sept Competitions entries should be in by the last Wednesday of August and so on)

**PRINTS** must be matted with a maximum matte size of 510mm x 410mm (20x16 ins). Minimum print sizes should be no smaller than 180mm x 125mm (7x5 ins). The back must be of a suitable material such as cardboard or foam board. Hot Shots in Duke St Cambridge or Kodak in Victoria St. will print and mount your prints at a reasonable rate, but you are responsible for collecting them and making sure they are correctly labeled on the back by the due date.

**NAMING YOUR IMAGE:** All entries must be supported by a digital file, titled and matching the title of the submitted image to

tina\_tait@xtra.co.nz along with an email laying out the grade-title and category. Images can also be submitted through a DropBox link.

**PROJECTED IMAGES** must not exceed a maximum size of 1620 pixels horizontal and 1080 pixels vertical.

All new members begin in C Grade and by earning points progress to A Grade. The competitions run throughout the year and members are awarded points based on the judges findings. Annual awards include Photographer of the Year, Best Projected, Best Print, Best Creative, Best Nature, and Best Floral Image.

During our last season we exhibited in the Autumn Arts Festival, where we had great success in displaying and selling our work. As a result we look forward in doing this again.
